How many new energy storage projects are commissioned in China?

Figure 2: Cumulative installed capacity of new energy storage projects commissioned in China (as of the end of June 2023) In the first half of 2023, China's new energy storage continued to develop at a high speed, with 850 projects (including planning, under construction and commissioned projects), more than twice that of the same period last year.

How big is China's energy storage capacity?

According to incomplete statistics from CNESA DataLink Global Energy Storage Database, by the end of June 2023, the cumulative installed capacity of electrical energy storage projects commissioned in China was 70.2GW, with a year-on-year increase of 44%.

What is China's Operational Energy Storage Project capacity?

Of this global capacity, China's operational energy storage project capacity totaled 32.7GW, a growth of 4.1% compared to Q2 of 2019. Global operational electrochemical energy storage project capacity totaled 10,112.3MW, surpassing a major milestone of 10GW, an increase of 36.1% compared to Q2 of 2019.

What will China's energy storage systems look like in 2024?

Furthermore, the sustained growth in the demand for utility-scale Energy Storage Systems (ESS), driven by challenges in the consumption of wind and solar energy, is noteworthy. TrendForce predicts that China's new utility-scale installations could reach 24.8 gigawatts and 55 gigawatt-hours in 2024.

What is China's new energy storage know-how?

Recently, China saw a diversifying new energy storage know-how. Lithium-ion batteries accounted for 97.4 percent of China's new-type energy storage capacity at the end of 2023. Aside from the lithium-ion battery, which is a dominant type, technical routes such as compressed air, liquid flow battery and flywheel storage are being developed rapidly.

How did China's electrochemical energy storage capacity compare to Q2?

Of this capacity, China's operational electrochemical energy storage capacity totaled 1,831.0MW, an increase of 53.9% compared to Q2 of 2019. Both in the global and Chinese markets, electrochemical energy storage capacities showed growth compared to their respective Q2 period in 2019, at 1.4% and 1.8%, respectively.

China aims to further develop its new energy storage capacity, which is expected to advance from the initial stage of commercialization to large-scale development by 2025, with an installed capacity of more than 30 million kW, and realize full market-oriented development of new energy storage by 2030, according to the National Development and ...

By the end of 2023, there were 39 ultra-high-voltage transmission projects. National transmission capacity exceeded 300 million kilowatts, further enhancing new energy consumption capacity, according to a report on China's new energy power generation published by the State Grid Energy Research Institute in Beijing.

In the field of energy storage, CATL's cumulative winning/signing of energy storage orders in 2023 is about 100GWh. Considering the current landscape of new energy development in China, encompassing installations and consumption, coupled with the rapid emergence of industrial and commercial energy storage, TrendForce anticipates China's new energy storage installations in 2024 to hit 29.2GW/66.3GWh.
