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TL;DR - Because of how flywheel energy storage scales it is unlikely that significant efforts will be made to develop the technology for home use. This is similar to the case for windmills, where the power output increases as the square of the diameter, and the cube of the wind speed (which itself doubles roughly every 20m of elevation).
